MINUTES OF THE AKELEY CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING HELD AT AKELEY CITY HALL 6:00PM, SEPTEMBER 24TH, 2025

The Akeley City Council met in a Special Meeting on September 24th, 2025. Mayor Brian Hitchcock called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

Council members present: Brian Hitchcock, Dan Riggs, and Bobbie Wosika

Council members absent: Dale Nelson

The reason for the special meeting was to discuss quotes for first street paving projects and to review financing for the above projects.

- Brian states that Anderson Brothers called before the city attorney got back to the city and stated that if there is government money involved that it was not something they should do. The proposal now being looked at is from Bemidji Bituminous. To pave one block on first street between 64 and Pleasant Ave SE will cost \$19,620.00 and to pave the other block of first street from Pleasant Ave SE to Franklin Ave will cost \$42,470.00. The total cost would be \$62,090.00. The amount in the road funds capital improvement account is \$46,174.30. There is a remainder of \$4,251.00 in the 2025 roads fund from Small Citty Assistance. If the city used that and \$11,691.50 from the road maintenance budget of 2025, it would cover the entire cost of the two blocks.
- Motion by Brian Hitchcock to approve the Bemidji Bituminous for the two blocks on the proposal in the amount of \$62,090.00, seconded by Dan Riggs, passed.

Motion by Bobbie Woiska to adjourn at 6:15pm, seconded by Dan Riggs, passed.
